### 2<sup>nd</sup> Fed4FIRE Competitive Call - Part A1 - Industrial Experimenters

#### Financial information:

- Total available funding for 2nd Open Call - Part A1: € 200 000
- Maximum requested funding per experiment dependent on country of origin

#### The proposer:

- must be eligible for participation in the EC FP7-projects
- Proposals will only be accepted from
  - A single party originating from an EU or Associate Member State
  - A single party from a Third Country (ICPC)

- A single party originating from an EU or Associate Member State together with a single party originating from a Third Country (High Income)
- Can only be selected for funding for one proposal (even if the proposer submitted multiple proposals that are ranked high enough to be selected for funding)
- Proposals have to be submitted by industrial organisations, including SMEs.

## **2<sup>nd</sup> Fed4FIRE Competitive Call - Part A2 - NON-Industrial Experimenters**

### **Financial information:**

- Total available funding for 2nd Open Call - Part A2: € 200 000
- Maximum requested funding per experiment dependent on country of origin

### **The proposer:**

- must be eligible for participation in the EC FP7-projects
- Proposals will only be accepted from
  - A single party originating from an EU or Associate Member State
  - A single party from a Third Country (ICPC)
  - A single party originating from an EU or Associate Member State together with a single party originating from a Third Country (High Income)
- Can only be selected for funding for one proposal (even if the proposer submitted multiple proposals that are ranked high enough to be selected for funding)
- Proposals have to be submitted by academic organisations or research institutions

## **2<sup>nd</sup> Fed4FIRE Competitive Call - Part B - Facility Providers**

- Maximum requested funding per experiment dependent on country of origin
- Total available funding for 2nd Open Call - Part B: € 400 000

### **The proposer:**

- must be eligible for participation in the EC FP7-projects
- Proposals will only be accepted from
  - A single party originating from an EU or Associate Member State
  - A single party from a Third Country (ICPC)
  - A single party originating from an EU or Associate Member State together with a single party originating from a Third Country (High Income)
- Can only be selected for funding for one proposal (even if the proposer submitted multiple proposals that are ranked high enough to be selected for funding)
